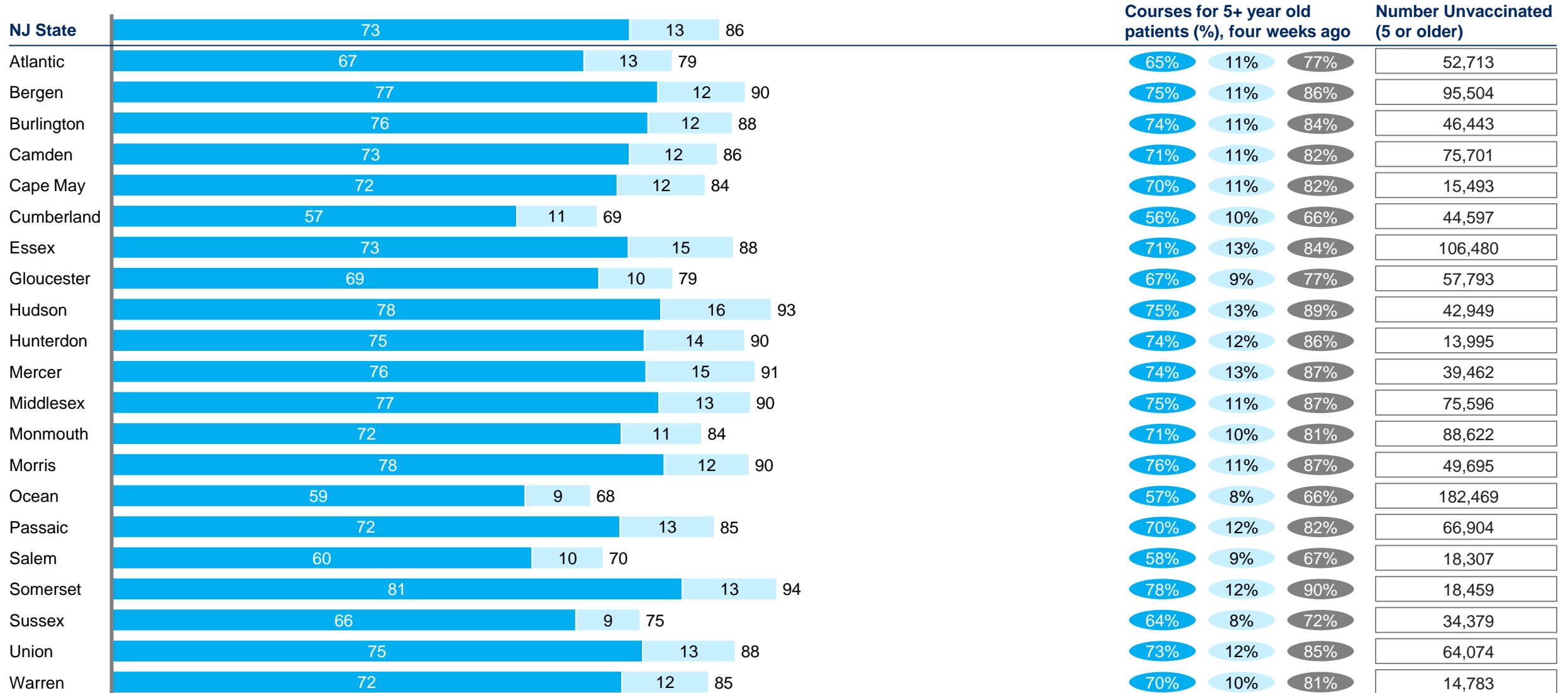

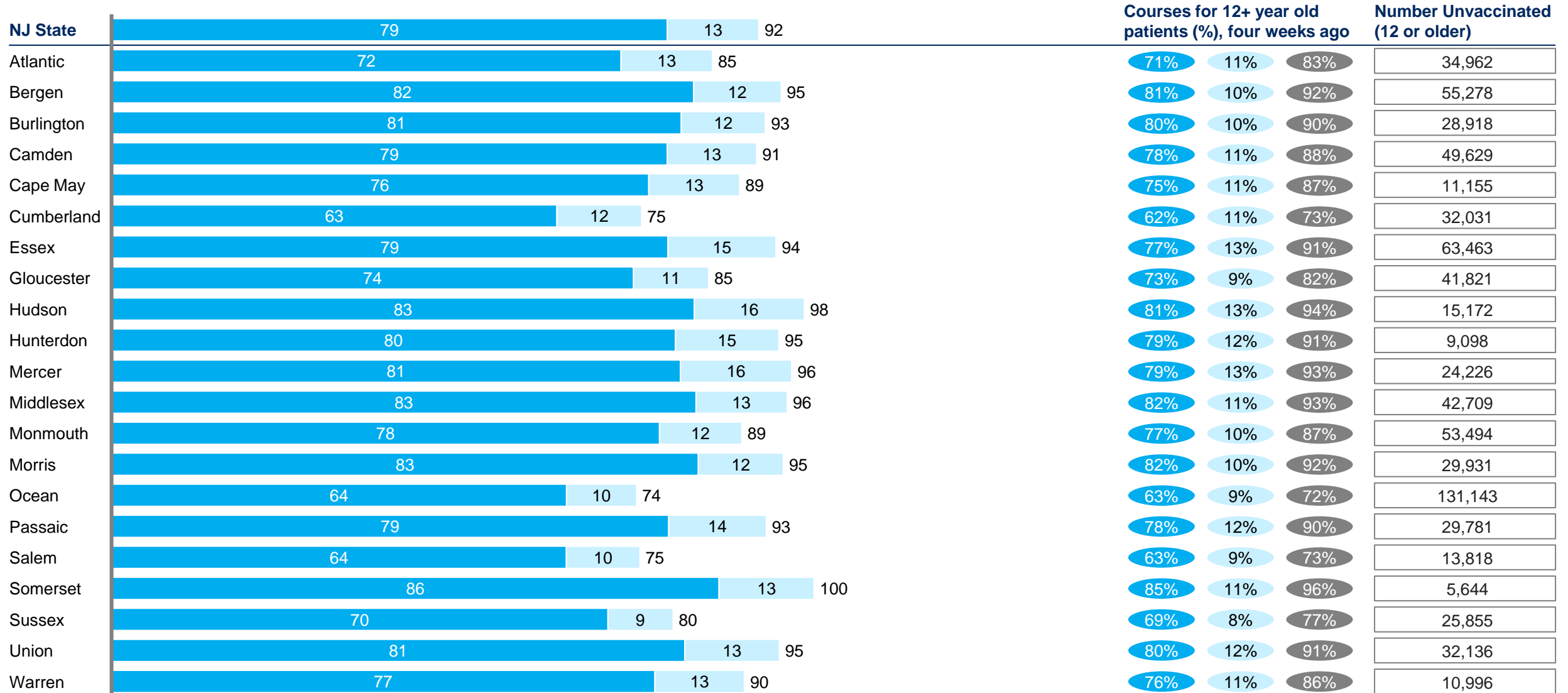

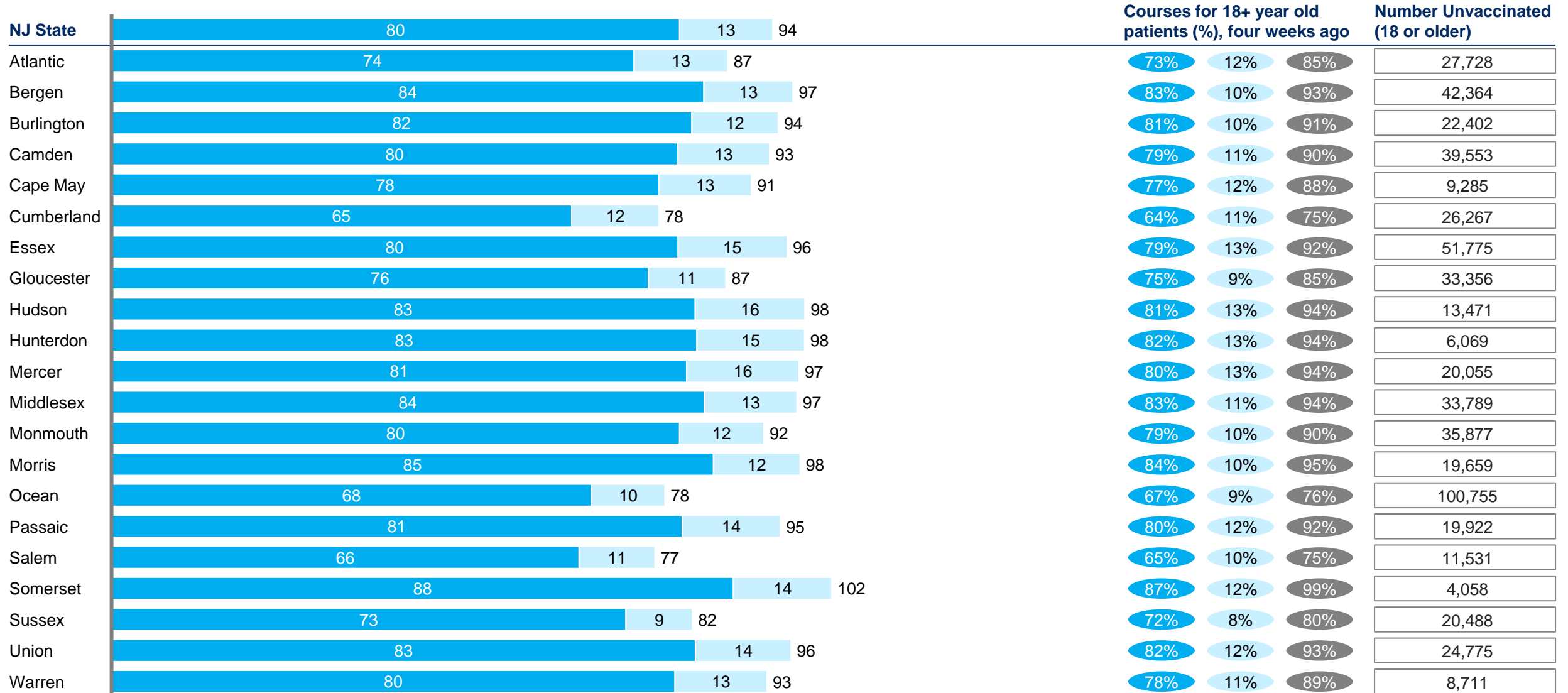

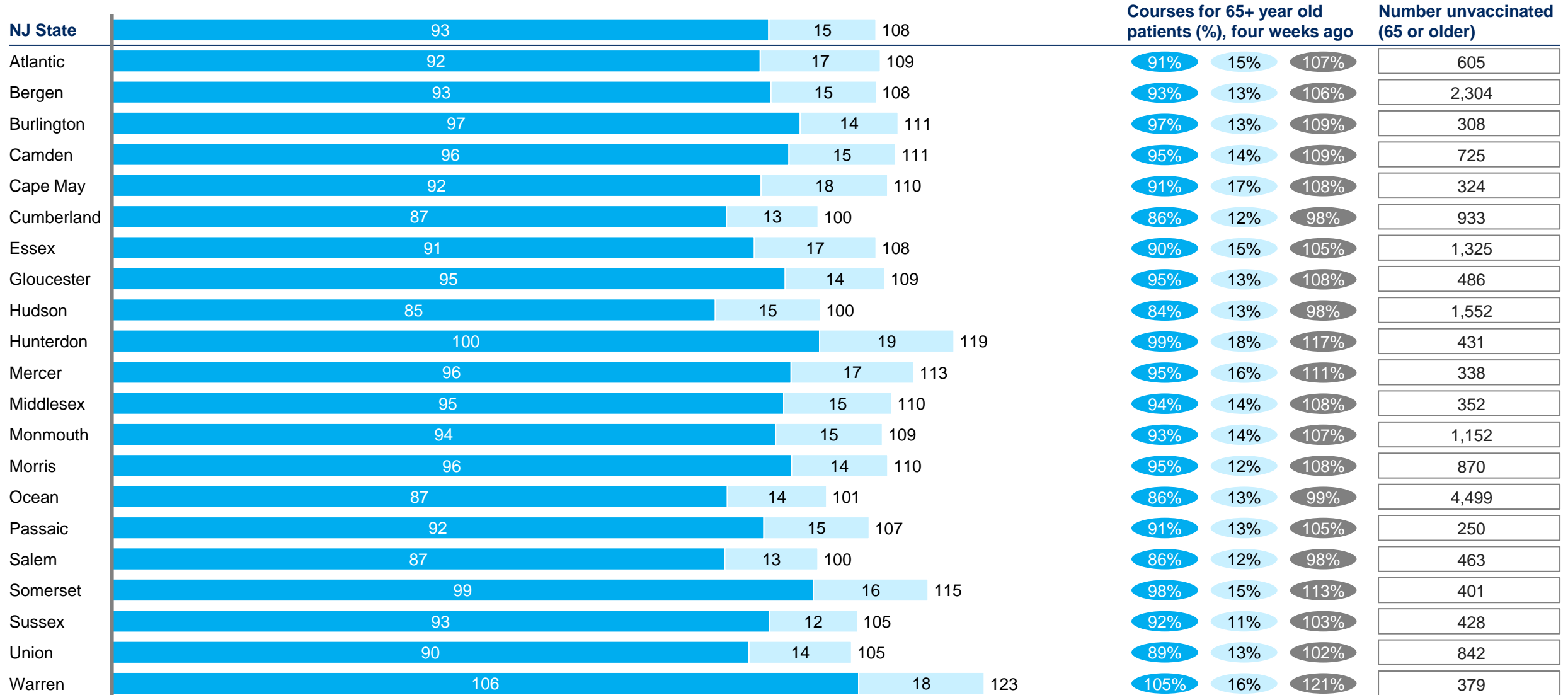

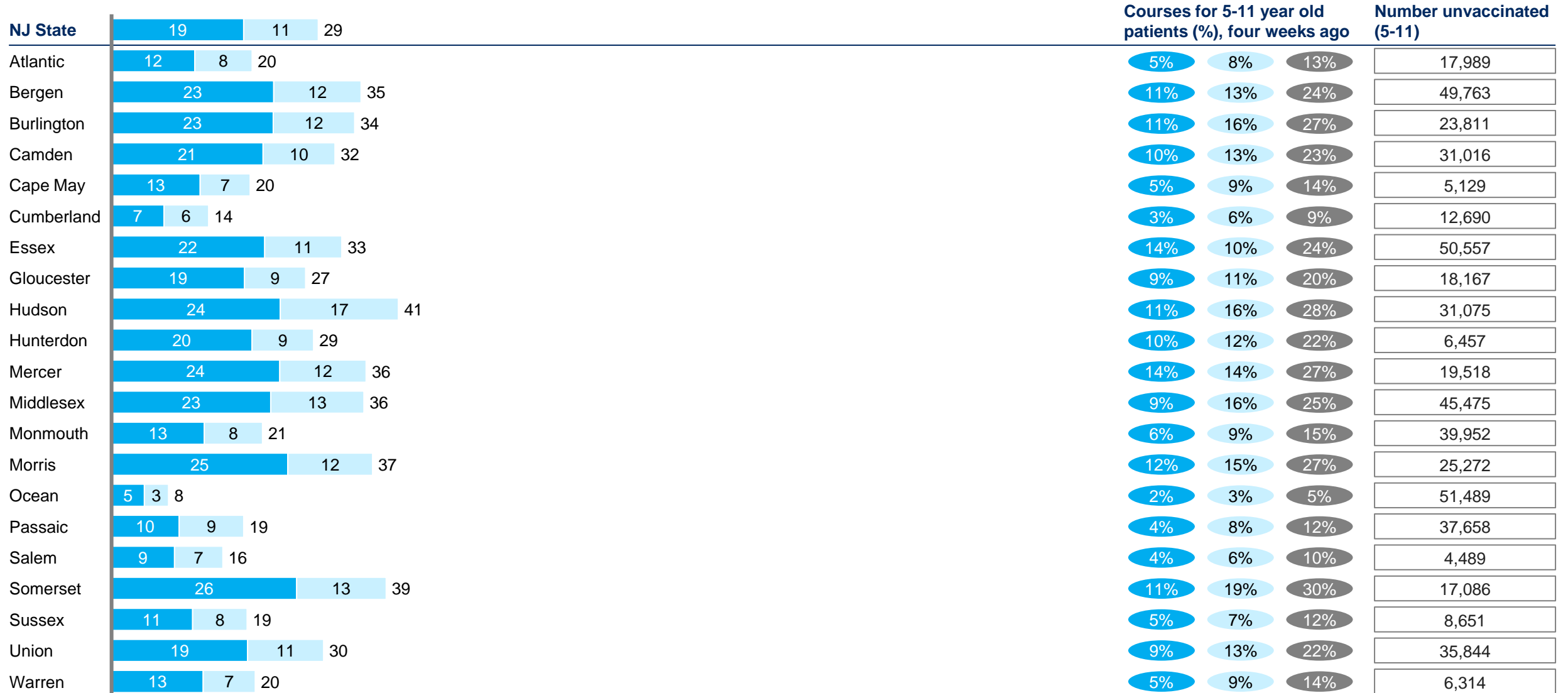

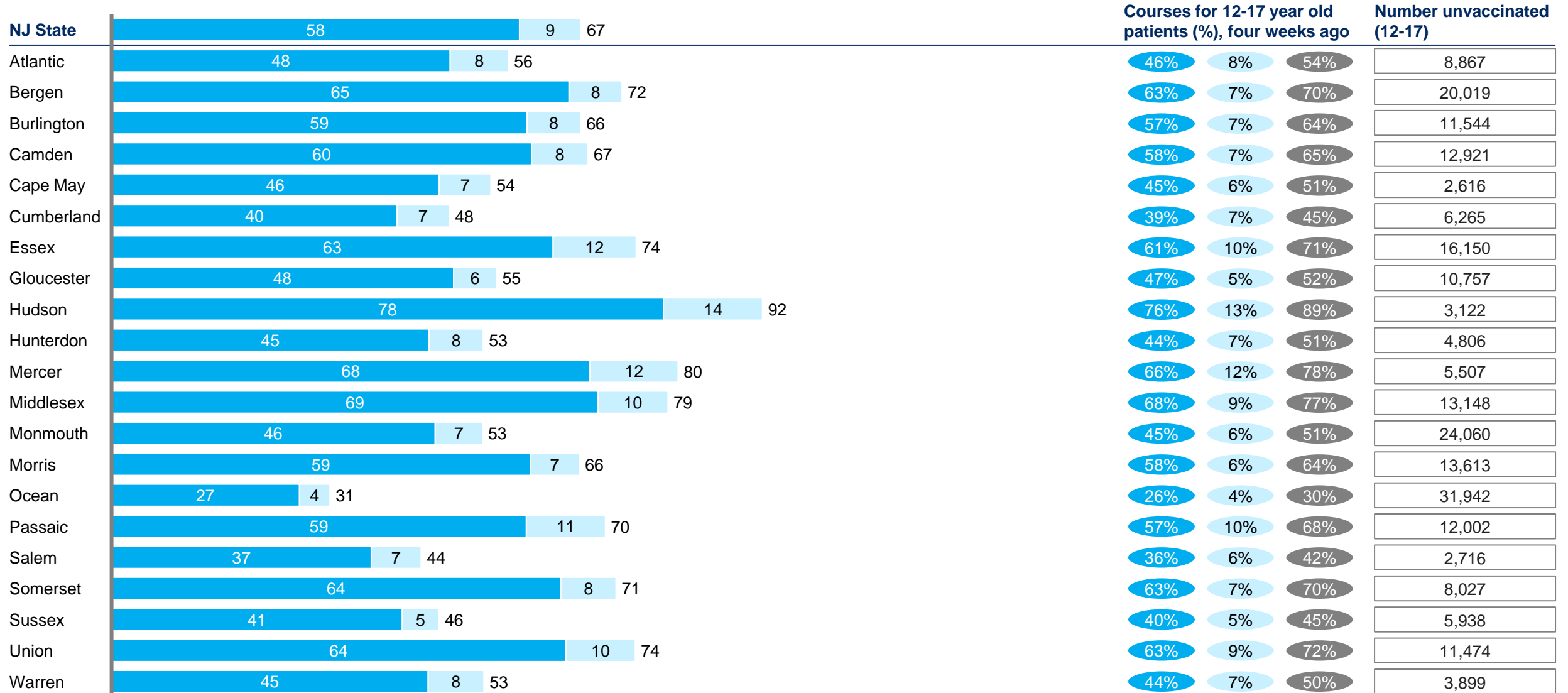
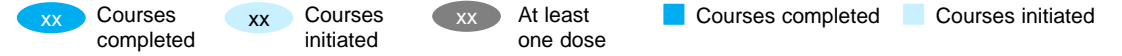

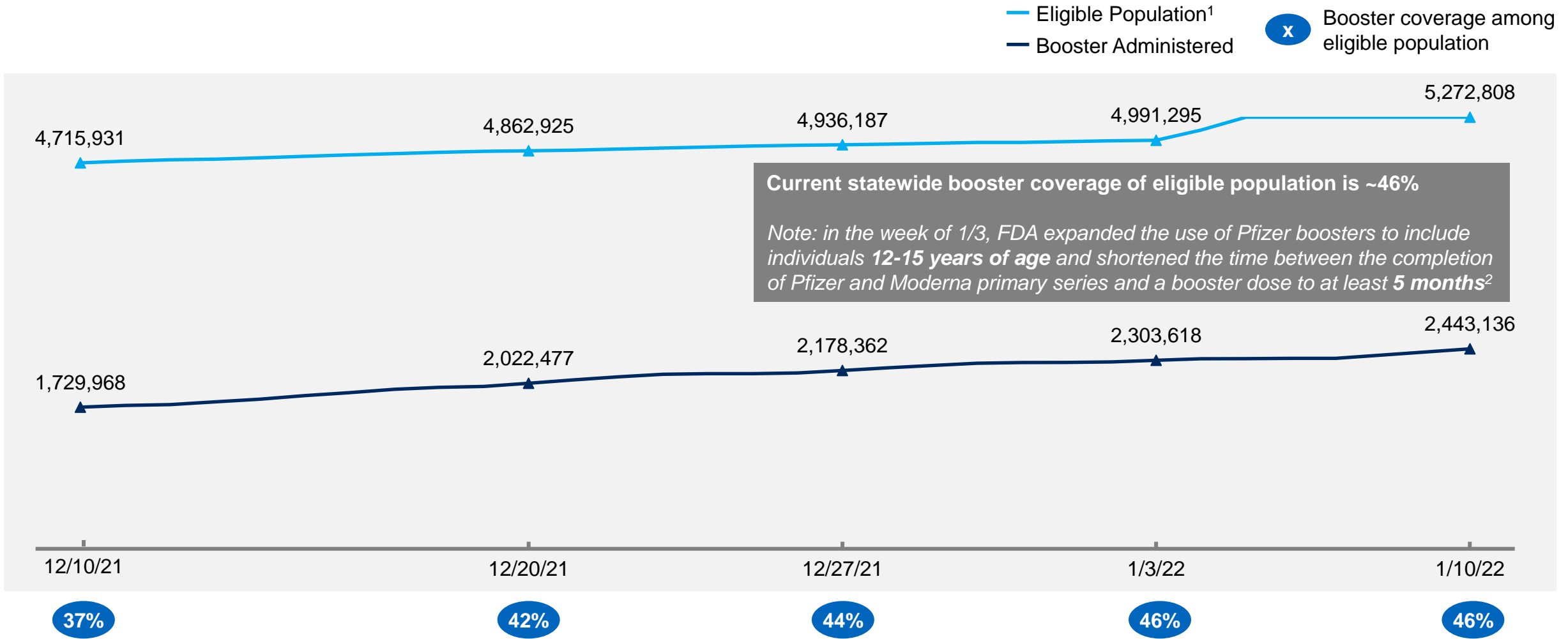

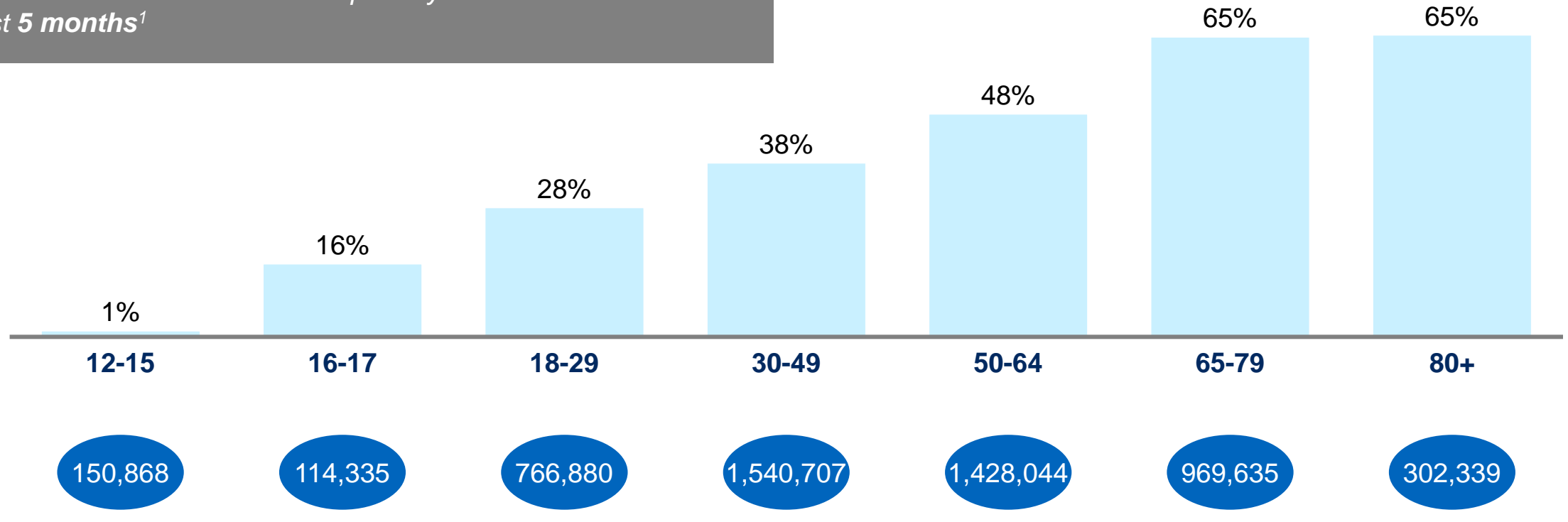

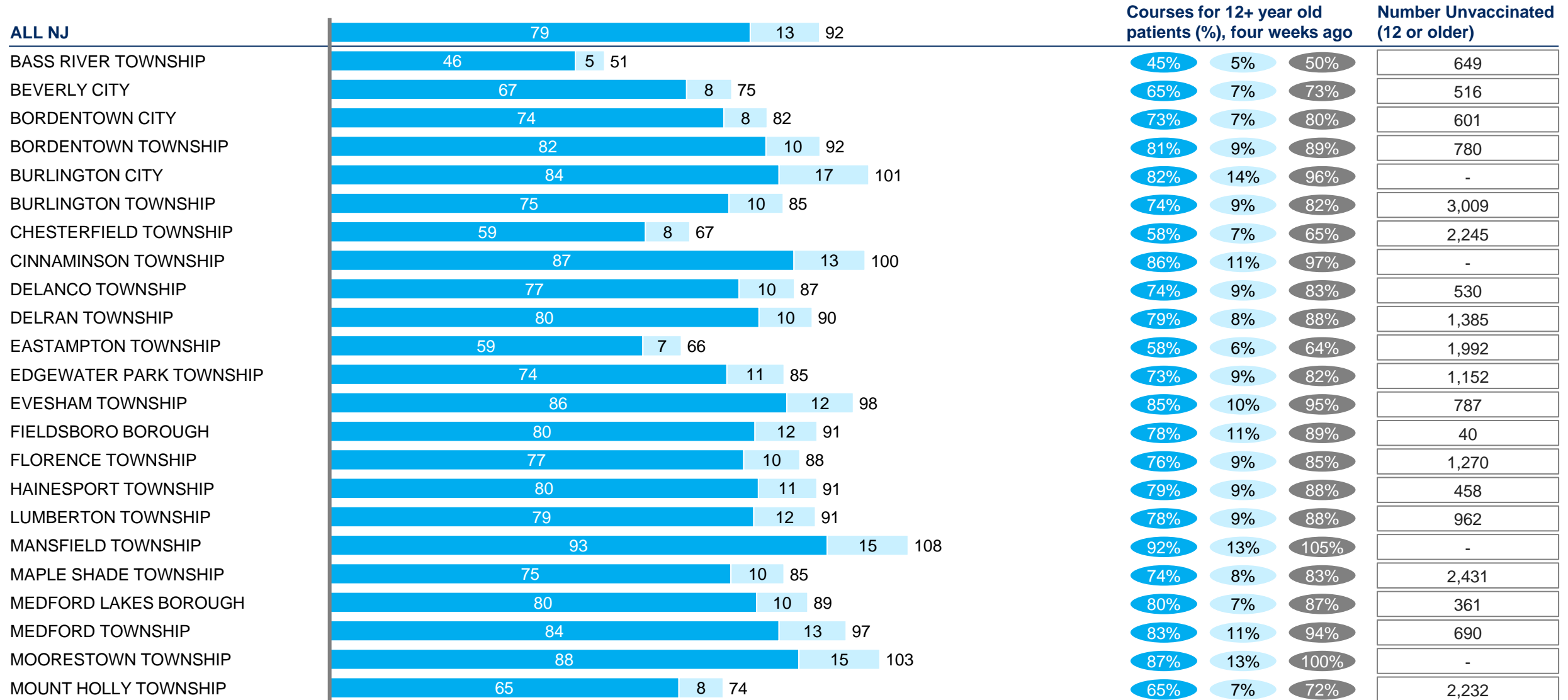

State-wide vaccine courses for 12+ year old patients (%)



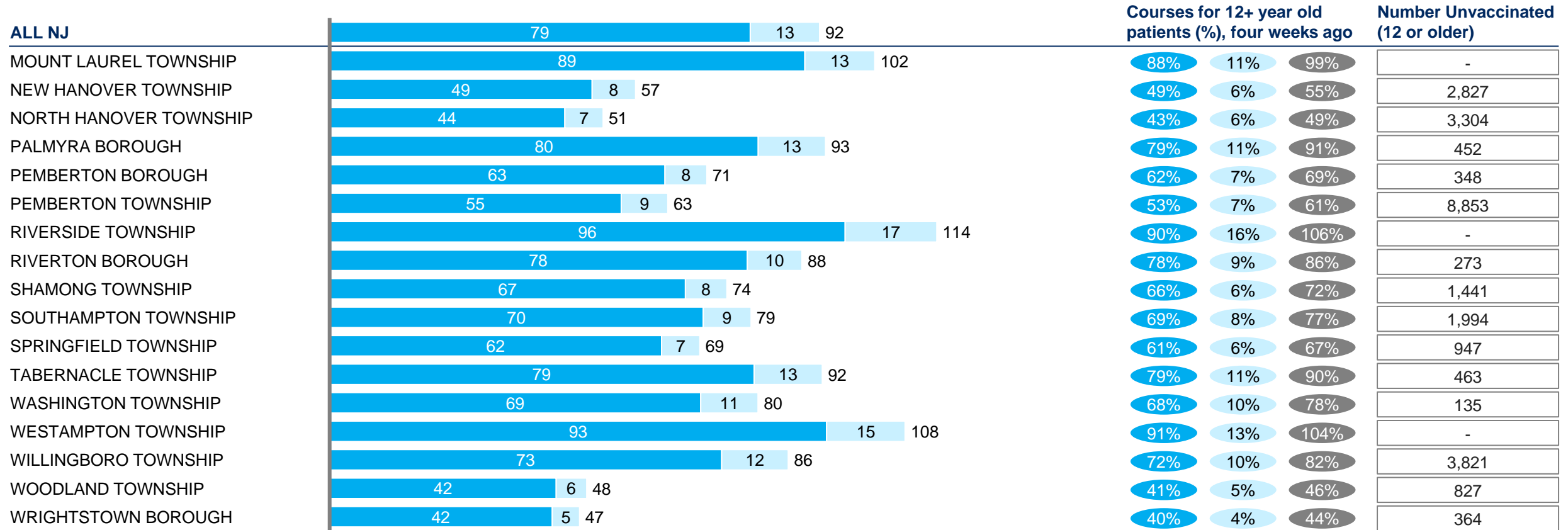

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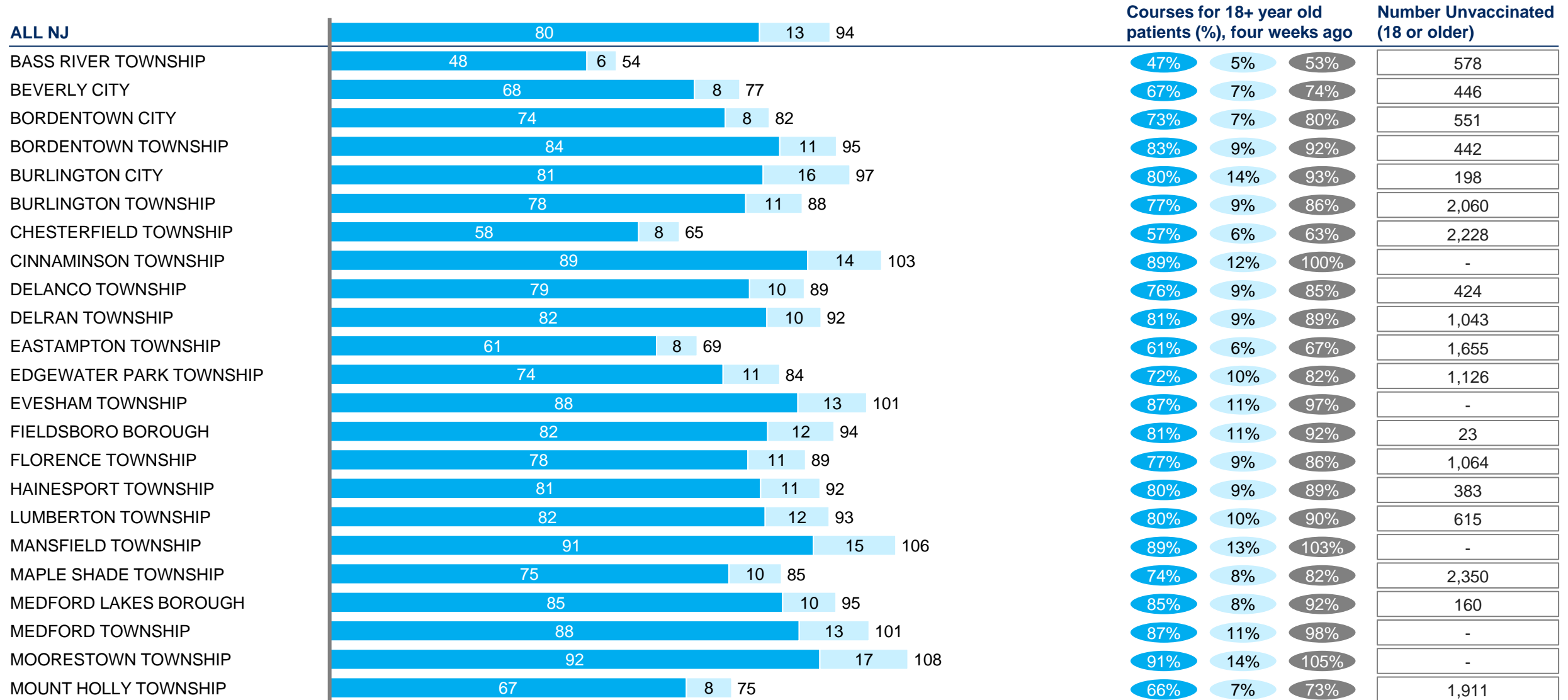


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Primary series coverage for 18+ year old patients in municipalities within Burlington County (1/2)

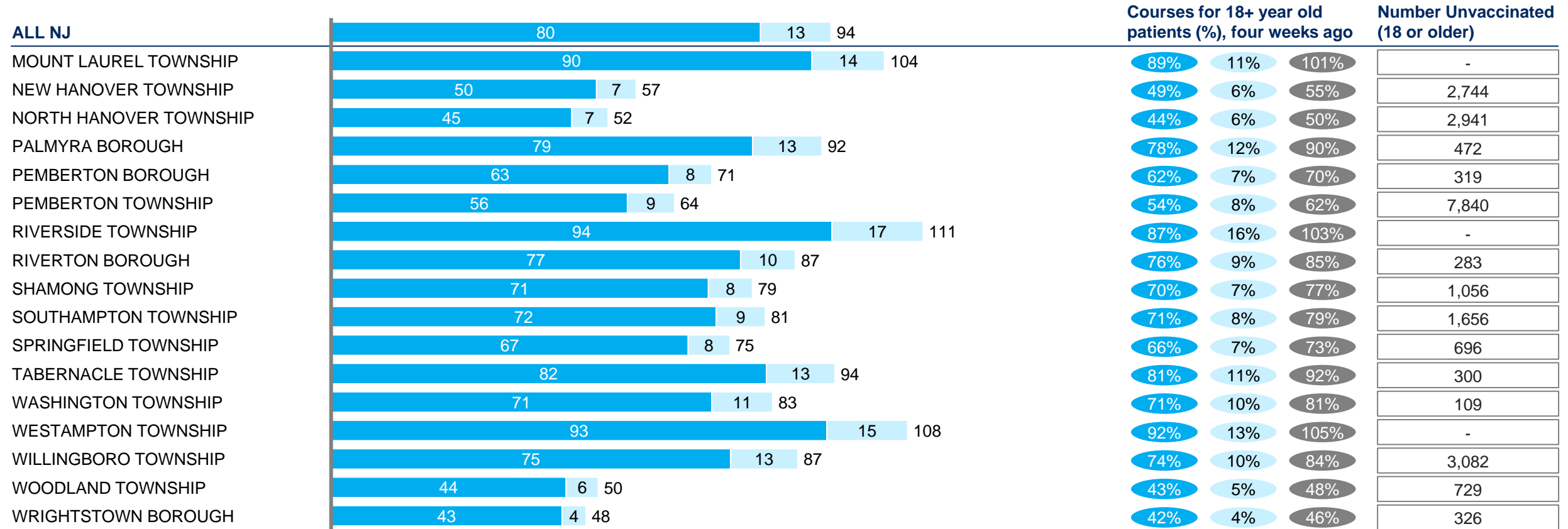

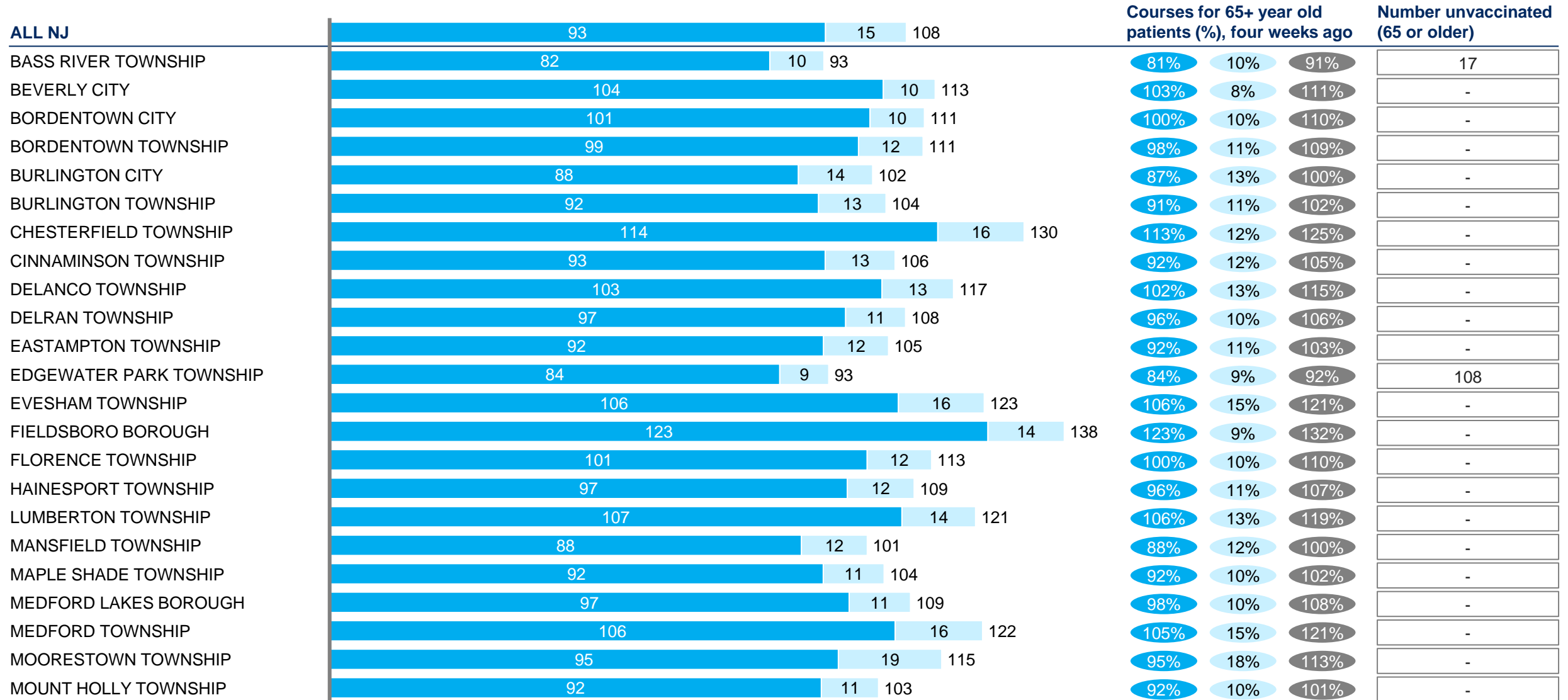

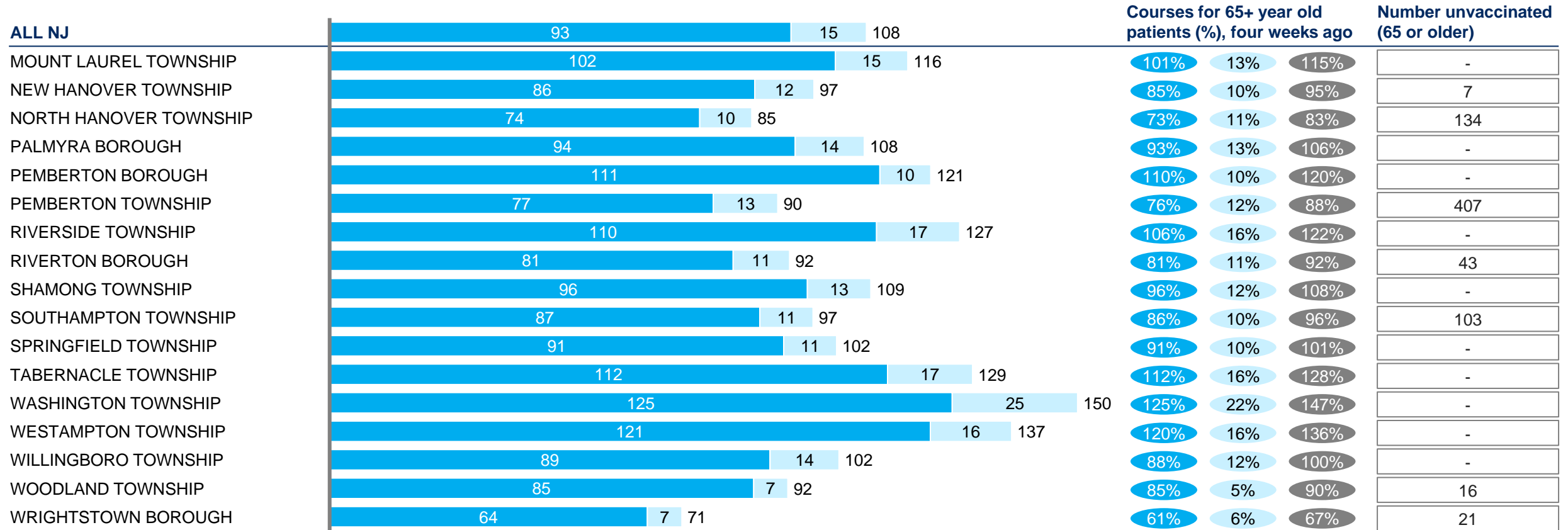
