After an initial interview with the program staff,  
if the case is appropriate and funding is  
available, a referral is made to a program  
attorney. Home and/or Facility visits are also  
available. The program is responsible  
for attorney's fees.

- \* Public Entitlements
- \* Housing-Landlord/Tenant Issues (Case By Case Basis)
- \* Medicare/Medicaid
- \* Representation Of Person (s) Proposed For or Under Guardianship/  
Conservatorship (Case By Case Basis)
- \* Abuse/Neglect (Contact Adult Protective Services)
