

NJ E-Bike & E-Scooter Regulations

- Low Speed E-Bikes (20 MPH) & Low-Speed Scooters (19 MPH) follow the same rules as traditional bikes, including obeying all traffic signals and moving in the direction of traffic.
 - £ E-Bikes and E-Scooters do **Not** require registration, license, or insurance, **EXCEPT** for Class 3 E-Bikes.
 - Melmets are required for riders under the age of 17.
 - & Riding on sidewalks is **NOT** permitted.
 - £ E-Bikes and E-Scooters parked on sidewalks may **NOT** block pedestrian access/movement or wheelchair access.
- Class 3 Motorized bikes (up to 28 MPH) require a license, registration, and helmet. Minimum of 15 years old with a valid moped or driver's license **IS** required. Helmets **MUST** be worn.
 - ***E-Bikes manufactured after 1/1/2019 must be tagged, showing classification, wattage, and top speed.
 - 🟂 Class 1: Pedal-Assist Only (Up to 20 MPH)
 - **Class 2**: Throttle-Assist, Assist Stops at 20 mph, Allows for operation with pedal-assist.
 - 6 Class 3: Fastest legal E-Bike, Pedal-Assist, Throttle Greater than 750 watts or 50cc, Top speed of up to 28 mph
 - **Solution** Can be impounded if unregistered or uninsured.
