## **DO NOT** RECYCLE:

**NO** shredded paper

**NO** Styrofoam

**NO** plastic with a



**NO** plastic bags,  
wrap, plastic envelopes,  
or shipping packaging

**NO** plant pots, straws,  
trays, lids, cups,  
or loose caps

**NO** hoses or hangers

**NO** hardback books,  
food soiled, or  
frozen food boxes

**NO** foil items, bulbs,  
cookware, or  
window glass

**NO** motor oil, batteries,  
or hazardous items

**NEVER** put syringes in recycling!

## CARDBOARD RECYCLING RULES

- We find hazardous items, like needles and batteries in boxes that residents set out for recycling.  
**FOR THIS REASON, YOU MUST EMPTY AND FLATTEN YOUR BOXES.**
- Never use boxes to hold ANY recyclables.
