 - From the curb to the street requires notification of sewerage authority; see procedure sheet.

 - √ Frame (Sheathing)
 - ✓ Insulation
 - ✓ Final Electric and/or Plumbing
 - √ Final Fire
 - ✓ Final Building
- If there are multiple sub-code permits, Building will always go last.

Inspections & Sub-Codes

Order of Inspections & Required Technical

sub-codes needed before a construction permit can be issued

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Required

- 1. Natural gas to natural as furnace replacement: Fire.
- Oil fired to oil fired furnace replacement: Plumbing, Fire, & Electrical.
- 3. Propane gas to natural gas furnace replacement: Plumbing & Fire.
- Oil to natural gas furnace replacement (What is being done with oil tank?): Plumbing, Fire, & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- Temporary heat connected to natural gas: Plumbing, Fire, & Electrical (if involved).
- Electric heat pump to natural gas fired furnace replacement: Plumbing, Fire, & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- Electric heat pump (new): Plumbing & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- Electric heat pump (replacement): Electrical.
- Solar heating and cooling systems: Building, Plumbing, Fire, & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- Water heater Oil or Electric (new): Plumbing, Fire (for gas), & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- 11. Water heater Gas replacement: Plumbing & Fire.
- Water heater Electric replacement: Plumbing & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- Water heater Oil replacement: Plumbing, Fire, & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- 14. Water heater Gas (new): Plumbing & Fire.
- Water heater electric (new): Plumbing & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- 16. **Air Conditioning (new):** Building, Plumbing, Fire (if gas operated), & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- Air Conditioning replacement: Fire (if gas operated) & Electrical (licensed contractor).
- 18. Clothes dryer: Building, Plumbing (if gas fired), Fire (if gas fired), & Electrical (if dryer is electric).

Technical

- Propane Tanks (residential above ground or in-ground): Plumbing, Fire, & Zoning.
- Propane Tanks (non-residential above ground or in-ground):
 Department of Labor shall be the sole enforcing agency. Building (for force), Zoning, Engineering.
- Above ground gas tank (inside or outside) new: Building, Plumbing, Fire, Electrical (if involved), Zoning, & Engineering.
- New tank installation Residential (fuel oil, gas, diesel):
 Building, Plumbing, Fire, Electrical (if there is a pump), & Engineering.
- New tank installation Commercial (fuel oil or gas): Building, Plumbing, Fire, Electrical, Zoning, & Engineering.
- 24. Underground storage tanks, fuel oil, & diesel, gas, removed from ground or filled in place: The following underground storage tanks are exempt from requiring a DEP approval permit for installation, repair, or closure: Fire
 - Farm or residential tanks of 2,000 gallons or less capacity used for storing motor fuel for noncommercial purposes.
 - Tanks with a capacity of 2,000 gallons or less use to store heating oil.
- 25. Fences over 6 feet high: Building & Zoning.
- Signs (Sq. Ft.): Building, Electrical (if illuminated), Zoning, & Engineering (if free standing).
- 27. Membrane Structures: Building, Fire, Zoning, & Engineering.
- Canopies & Awnings: Building, Fire, Electrical (if illuminated), & Zoning.
- Kitchen Exhaust System (commercial): Building, Fire, & Electrical.
- Asbestos Abatement: Building (licensed contractor).
 Educational & public buildings, any building that houses a day care center, nursery, or educational facility.
- 31. Above ground swimming pool: Building, Electrical, & Zoning.
- In-ground pool: Building, Plumbing (if gas heated), Electrical, Zoning, & Engineering.
- 33. **Masonry Fireplaces**: Building, Plumbing (for gas logs or log lighters installed), Fire, & Electrical (electrical fan).

Sub-Codes

- Factory built fireplaces: Building, Plumbing (for gas logs or log lighters installed). Fire. & Electrical (electric fan).
- 35. Chimneys & vents: Building & Fire.
- Residential elevator: Building, Fire, Electrical, & Elevator.
- 37. Commercial elevator: Building, Fire, Electrical, & Elevator.
- Tennis courts: Building (fence if over 6 feet high), Electrical, Zoning, & Engineering.
- Radio & television towers: Building, Electrical, Zoning, & Engineering.
- Radio & television antennas: Building (more than 12 feet in height above roof) & Electrical.
- Dish antenna more than 2' in diameter: Building, Electrical, & Zoning.
- 42. Lawn sprinklers: Plumbing.
- Garbage disposal: Engineering.
- Mechanical refrigeration: Plumbing, Fire, Electrical, & Department of Labor.
- Boiler & pressure vessels: Building, Plumbing, Fire, Electrical, Department of Labor (high pressure).
- 46. Storage trailer: Building, Zoning, & Engineering.
- Construction trailer: Building, Fire, Electrical, Zoning, & Engineering.
- Sales trailer: Building, Plumbing (if has sewer connected toilet), Fire, Electrical, Zoning, & Engineering.
- 49. Spray booth: Building, Fire, & Electrical.
- 50. Spray room: Building, Fire, & Electrical.
- 51. Spray storage rooms: Building & Fire.
