



CHIPPING SERVICE & LEAF DISPOSAL

Chipping has resumed for Spring of 2020 until October. If you would like to arrange to bring brush to the garage, fill out the [Chipping Appointment Form](#).

Chipping service is NOT for residents who are removing trees, bushes, and/or major yard work. It is the responsibility of the homeowner or occupant to dispose of the debris.

The Public Works Department will NOT remove debris if an outside contractor was used. The contractor is responsible for removing all debris.

CHIPPABLE ITEMS: Branches 4 feet and longer, no more than 8 inches in diameter. Residents are responsible for the removal of all stumps and trunks from trees that are cut down from their properties.

Branches must be on the curb with ends facing the same way; if all cut ends are not facing toward the street, residents will be asked to restack branches.



NON-CHIPPABLE ITEMS: Old firewood, logs, loose bark, bushes and shrubbery with dirt

and roots; stumps and branches shorter than four feet.

LEAVES: All leaves must be BAGGED. Leaves will not be picked up in bulk by leaf picker again until the end of October. Call the Township Garage at 609-877-2050, x5 or x400 for pickup.
