Recycling labels on plastic packaging can confuse and even mislead the best recyclers. Despite what a label may say, **NEVER PUT PLASTIC PACKAGING IN YOUR RECYCLING BIN!**

HERE ARE OUR TOP PLASTIC PACKAGING CONTAMINANTS & HOW TO HANDLE THEM

YOUR RECYCLING PROGRAM IS FUNDED BY THE BURLINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.


AMAZON MAILER
Remove paper label and take to store dropoff*.

AIR PILLOWS
Deflate and take to store dropoff*.

STYROFOAM
No recycling program available; place in trash.

RENEW LINERS
FALSELY claims you can recycle it at the curb. **This is NOT TRUE.** No curbside or store dropoff programs in NJ will recycle it; place in trash.

Carts with **PLASTIC BAGS** and other **"DO NOT RECYCLE"** items **WILL NOT BE COLLECTED!**



RECYCLE:

Paper and Cardboard
EMPTY, FLATTEN & FOLD



Plastic Bottles and Food Containers

Empty and rinse containers.



Glass Bottles and Jars

Labels are okay!
No caps or lids.



Metal CANS Only

Empty, *non-hazardous* aerosol cans are okay! **Don't flatten cans!**



Cartons



SET RECYCLING OUT BY 6 AM

Metal bar must face the street.

DO NOT RECYCLE:

NO hoses or hangers



NO hardback books, food soiled, or frozen food boxes



NO foil items, bulbs, cookware, or window glass



NO motor oil, batteries, or hazardous items



NO plastic with a



NO Styrofoam



NO plastic envelopes, bags, wrap, or shipping packaging



NO plant pots, trays, lids, cups, or coffee pods



NO shredded paper



NEVER put syringes in recycling!

CARDBOARD RECYCLING RULES

- We find hazardous items, like needles and batteries in boxes that residents set out for recycling. **FOR THIS REASON, YOU MUST FLATTEN AND EMPTY YOUR BOXES.**
- Never use boxes to hold ANY recyclables.



DID YOU KNOW?

You can recycle rechargeable batteries at Home Depot, Lowes, and other big box stores.
