AIR PILLOWS Deflate and take to store dropoff*.

STYROFOAM No recycling program available; place in trash.

RENEW LINERS

FALSELY claims you can recycle it at the curb. **This is NOT TRUE**. No curbside or store dropoff programs in NJ will recycle it; place in trash.
