

**TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER PARK  
ORDINANCE 6-2007**

*An Ordinance of the Township of Edgewater Park Amending the  
Code of the Township of Edgewater Park to Add a Section  
regulating the Use of the Streets and the Sidewalks within the  
Township.*

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park has determined that there is a need to provide for the public safety and for the safe use of the streets and sidewalks and to prevent motor vehicle accidents and to provide for the safety of citizens,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that the Code of the Township be and is hereby amended as follows:

**Section 1.:** The Code of the Township of Edgewater Park is hereby amended by adding the following:

**Use of the Public Right-of-Way**

- a. *Obstruction Prohibited.* No person shall place in any right of way, street, or sidewalk in the Township any article which would tend to obstruct the free passage of pedestrians and vehicles along the right of way, street or sidewalks. The following are examples of items which tend to obstruct the free passage of pedestrians and vehicles, but such listing is intended to be typical and by way of example only and shall not be construed as exclusive, namely, merchandise, signs, showcases, crates and barrels and other materials or equipment used in connection with the operation of a trade or business, basketball standards, hockey nets and other sports equipment.
- b. No basketball standards or other sports equipment shall be placed on private property in a manner which will encourage or permit the play or sports activity to take place on the streets or sidewalks or within the right-of-way.
- c. Playing or loitering in the street is prohibited.
- d. *Penalties.* The penalty for violation of this section shall be a fine defined under Section 1.08.010 et seq as amended by Ordinance No. 7-2006.

**Section 2.** If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

**Section 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Edgewater Park heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage. Notice of adoption shall be published as provided by law.

**Ordinance No. 1-2007**

*AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER PARK PROVIDING  
FOR AND DETERMINING THE RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR  
EMPLOYEES FOR THE YEAR 2007*

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 2:2-1. The annual rates of compensation of officers and employees whose compensation shall be payable bi-weekly shall be as follows:

SECTION 2:2-2. The annual rates of compensation of officers and employees whose compensation shall be paid quarterly shall be as follows:

SECTION 2:2-3. The annual rates of compensation of officers and employees whose compensation shall be payable annually shall be as follows:

SECTION 2:2-4. The compensation of officers and employees whose compensation shall be payable upon completion of said duty and approval by respective Chairperson:

Secretary, Planning Board	\$ 150 (per meeting)

For each special meeting called by the Chairman for a developer, said developer is responsible for the reimbursement of the meeting fee.

SECTION 2:2-5. The rates of compensation of employees whose compensation falls within a variable range shall be fixed by resolution from time to time.

SECTION 2:2-6. Longevity payments shall be in accordance with respective contracts.

SECTION 2:2-7. The rates of compensation for professionals appointed by Township Committee at its reorganization meeting are as follows:

Solicitor - \$30,000 per year (Base Amount); (support services based on fee schedule)

Special Counsel - support services based on fee schedule

Engineer - \$125 per meeting (support services based on fee schedule)

Special Engineer - support services based on fee schedule

Auditor - \$26,000 (Base Amount) (support services based on fee schedule)

Prosecutor - \$375.00 (per session); (support services based on fee schedule)

Public Defender - \$375.00 (per session); (support services based on fee schedule)

Risk Manager - support services based on fee schedule

SECTION 2:2-8. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication according to law, but the terms of compensation provided herein shall be effective as of January 1, 2007, and shall apply only to those persons in employment at the date of adoption of this ordinance. This ordinance is intended to repeal all prior ordinances dealing with salaries in the Township of Edgewater Park in their entirety.

**ORDINANCE NO. 3-2007**

*AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER  
PARK, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW  
JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 10.16 OF THE  
TOWNSHIP CODE, TITLED "SPEED LIMITS FOR SPECIFIC STREETS"*

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER PARK, in the County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION ONE. Amendment**

This Ordinance shall amend Chapter 10.16 titled "**Speed Limits for Specific Streets**" of the Township Code, by deleting the language in Section (B) of Section 10.16.010, and adding the following in Section 10.16.010 (B)., titled "**Speed Limits Established**" as follows:

Name of Streets:

- B. The speed limits for both directions of traffic along Perkins Lane from its intersection with Bridgeboro Road to the Edgewater Park-Delanco Township line in the township is established as **25 Miles Per Hour**

**SECTION TWO. Implementation**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication according to law.

**CALENDAR YEAR 2007**  
**ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS**  
**AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK**  
**(N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)**

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park in the County of Burlington finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2007 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee hereby determines that a 3.5 % increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$41,681.62 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

**WHEREAS** the Township Committee hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park, in the County of Burlington, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2007 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Edgewater Park shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5 %, amounting to \$ 145,885.67 , and that the CY 2007 municipal budget for the Township of Edgewater Park be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

**TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER PARK  
ORDINANCE NO. 5-2007**

*AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER PARK,  
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING  
CHAPTER 5.20 EDGEWATER PARK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED  
“MOTOR VEHICLE WRECKERS”*

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park has determined that there is a need to amend the established schedule of towing and storage services based on the usual, customary, and reasonable rates of operator, towing and storing motor vehicles in the Township of Edgewater Park and County of Burlington, which it will require all Edgewater park wreckers to adhere to.

**WHEREAS**, Township Committee wishes to amend Chapter 5.20 established by Ordinance No. 10-98, adopted September 16, 1998.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park, County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey, that the Township Code of the Township of Edgewater Park is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** SECTION 5.20.020E Is Hereby Repealed And Replaced With The Following:

5.20.020E. In its contract with the Township, the wrecker will instances where towing and storage of motor vehicles is being provided without the consent of the owner of said vehicle, agree to charge for basic towing and storage services rates identical to the following model:

1. Basic Towing Fees (Monday through Friday)
  - A. During the hours of 9:00 am to 5:00pm - \$65.00 plus \$10.00 for mileage.
  - B. During the hours of 5:00pm to 9:00am - \$75.00 plus \$10.00 for mileage.
2. Saturday and Sunday Towing Service Fees
  - A. \$75.00 plus \$10.00 mileage.
3. Storage Fees
  - A. Inside Storage - \$35.00 per day.
  - B. Outside Storage - \$25.00 per day.
4. Recovery and/or rollover rates.
  - A. The vehicle’s owner will be charged as per the appropriate towing fee based upon the day and time of service together with a winching charge of \$75.00 per hour, billed at fifteen-minute intervals.
5. Miscellaneous Fees.
  - A. Clean-up provided by wrecker at the accident scene - \$25.00 - \$45.00 per vehicle, depending on the quantity of debris.
  - B. Administrative fee - \$35.00 per vehicle.

The contract will be available to the public for inspection during the normal business hours of the municipal clerk's office.

**SECTION TWO:** All ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the Provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION THREE:** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provisions of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
