

**TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER PARK
ORDINANCE NO. 2009-10**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER PARK, IN THE
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, DESIGNATING THE
INTERSECTION OF GREEN STREET AND BRIDGEBORO ROAD AS A 4-
WAY STOP INTERSECTION**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park is authorized by the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 39:4-197*, to enact ordinances establishing traffic regulations controlling congested street corners, including the establishment of multi-way stop controls, and

WHEREAS, Green Street and Bridgeboro Road are municipal roads with motorists on Green Street required to stop at the intersection while motorists on Bridgeboro Road are not required to stop, and

WHEREAS, the traffic at that intersection has continually increased while there is limited sight distance for motorists on Green Street causing those motorists to make dangerous entry into the intersection with Bridgeboro Road, and

WHEREAS, Township Committee of the Township of Edgewater Park has received a report and certification from the Township Engineer, dated May 21, 2000, that it is in the interest of public safety that the intersection of Green Street and Bridgeboro Road be designated as a 4-way full stop intersection, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED By The Committee Of The Township Of Edgewater Park, In The County Of Burlington, New Jersey That:

Section 1. The intersection of Green Street and Bridgeboro Road be and hereby is designated as a 4-way, full-stop intersection.

Section 2. Signage and striping at the intersection shall be installed in accordance with the standards as promulgated in the Manual on Traffic Control Devices and the New Jersey Department of Transportation, supplement in accordance with the Report of the Township Engineer, dated May 21, 2009.

Section 3. In the event that any section or portion of this Ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative, in whole or in part, by a court of competent jurisdiction, each section or part shall, to the extent that it is unconditional, invalid, or inoperative, remain in full force and affect and no such determination shall be deemed to invalidate the remaining sections or parts of this ordinance or the ordinance as a whole.

Section 4. The Township Committee finds that the regulations established in this Ordinance address a matter of public safety and the Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment and publication as provided by Law.

NOTICE

The foregoing was introduced by the Edgewater Park Township Committee at its meeting held on June 2, 2009. This ordinance will be consider for adoption of final reading and public hearing to be held on June 16, 2009 at 7:00 PM, or shortly thereafter, in the Municipal Building, 400 Delanco Road, Edgewater Park, New Jersey. At which time and place all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
