Weimann Sports Complex Review

Township Committee reviewed that the Township was awarded a total of \$325,000 through the Burlington County Parks Grants Program. The total amount of the improvement project is approximately \$522,000; this does not include professional services for engineering and legal. Various options were reviewed. Upon further discussion consensus of Committee to move forward with a base bid for improvements to the driveway entrance and parking; lighting upgrades will also be included in the project at an additional cost. The base bid will also include improvements to the clubhouse which includes the kitchen, meeting room, bathroom improvements, doors, outside painting and repairs; the roof replacement will not be done at this time. Alternates will include improvements to the tennis and basketball courts and the baseball field.

The discussion continued regarding the improvements to the municipal building parking lot, storm water management, the installation of the pole barn at the public works garage and recycling area improvements. Bids will be prepared and advertised at the same time; the

municipal building and ground improvements and the improvements at the public works area will be bid separately.


