

New Alert System in Edgewater Park

Attention Residents of Edgewater Park! On January 1, 2014 the Township of Edgewater Park activated a new emergency alert system for our town.

The system, also known as Code Red, is a shared system with Burlington County Emergency Management and other municipalities in Burlington County. This system, as you may have already experienced, will notify all of our residents and businesses of any emergencies or serious weather events. This system replaced our old Global Connect System. Code Red will allow us to notify you not only by telephone (land line) but by cell phone, email or text message. You may choose one option or all options; it is up to you how you would like to be notified. Many residents no longer have land lines so sign up using your cell phone number. Entering your cell phone information will also provide you with information about Edgewater Park when you are away from home.

In order to take advantage of all options of the emergency notification system simply register and choose the way you would like to be notified. There is no charge for this service. Once you are connected to the site enter your name, address, phone number, cell number and/or email address; the site will not ask for any other personal or confidential information. Businesses can also sign up so that they get notified as well. You can also change or remove the information that you entered at any time.
