ONLY ESSENTIAL BCTS PARATRANSIT SERVICES
FOR TRANSPORTATION TO OPERATE THURSDAY

Pending Snow Forces Cancellation of Senior Lunch Sites, Veterans, Shopping

Burlington County's Office on Aging will not operate its lunch programs at nutrition centers or Meals on Wheels on Thursday, Feb. 25, due to the weather forecast for significant snow and hazardous daytime driving conditions.

Also, Veterans Transportation Service, and BCTS paratransit service for seniors and those with disabilities will operate on a limited basis, including Shopping Service for Thursday being rescheduled for Friday.

The Office on Aging operates nutrition programs in Beverly at the First Baptist Church and in Bordentown at the Carlslake Community Center as well as the Samuel Miller Retirement Center in Mount Holly on Thursdays.

Veterans with appointments at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Philadelphia have been notified to reschedule those appointments. Veterans Transportation operates Tuesday-Friday.

Shopping Service for Zone 4 – the Bordentowns, Chesterfield, Fieldsboro, Mansfield, New Hanover, North Hanover, the Pembertons, Springfield, Wrightstown and Woodland – will be offered shopping service on Friday. Shopping Service regularly scheduled for Friday – Eastampton, Hainesport, Lumberton, Medford, Medford Lakes, Mount Holly, Shamong, Southampton and Tabernacle – still will be available on Friday.

Limited transportation for essential medical appointments only, including dialysis, will be available upon confirmation by the client that the medical facility is open. CT Student Services, which operates the BCTS, has been rescheduling Thursday reservations.
