October 16th Deadline For Burlington County In Action

The Sheriff's Department is presenting *Burlington County in Action*, six two-hour sessions as part of the LIFE (Learning Is For Everyone) Program sponsored by Burlington County College.

Held on Thursday's from 1-3 p.m. beginning October 16, *Burlington County In Action* will provide seniors with the opportunity to learn about fire prevention, crime prevention, consumer fraud prevention, K-9 training and units, and senior health issues as well as touring the County's Central Communications in the Public Safety Center in Westampton.

Burlington County In Action will be held at the Emergency Services Training Center in Westampton and is limited to the first 40 to register.

LIFE is for adults 55 and older and is under the "umbrella" of Elderhostel. LIFE at Burlington County College was founded in 1990 and now has 225 members.

Annual membership fee for LIFE is \$80 and entitles members to free courses during the three semesters (Sept.-Dec.; Jan.-March; April-June) at BCC.
